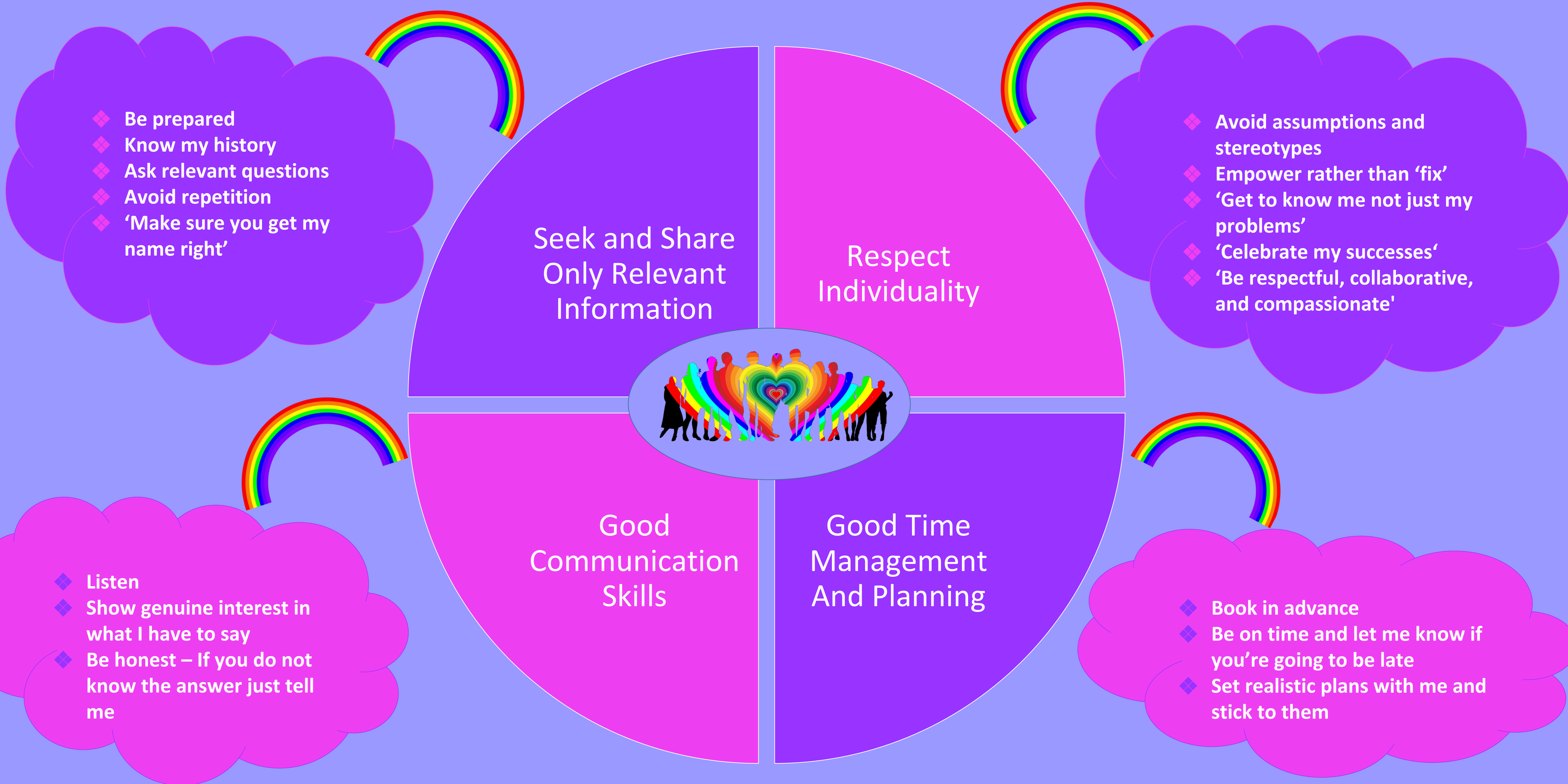


Hear Our Voice
