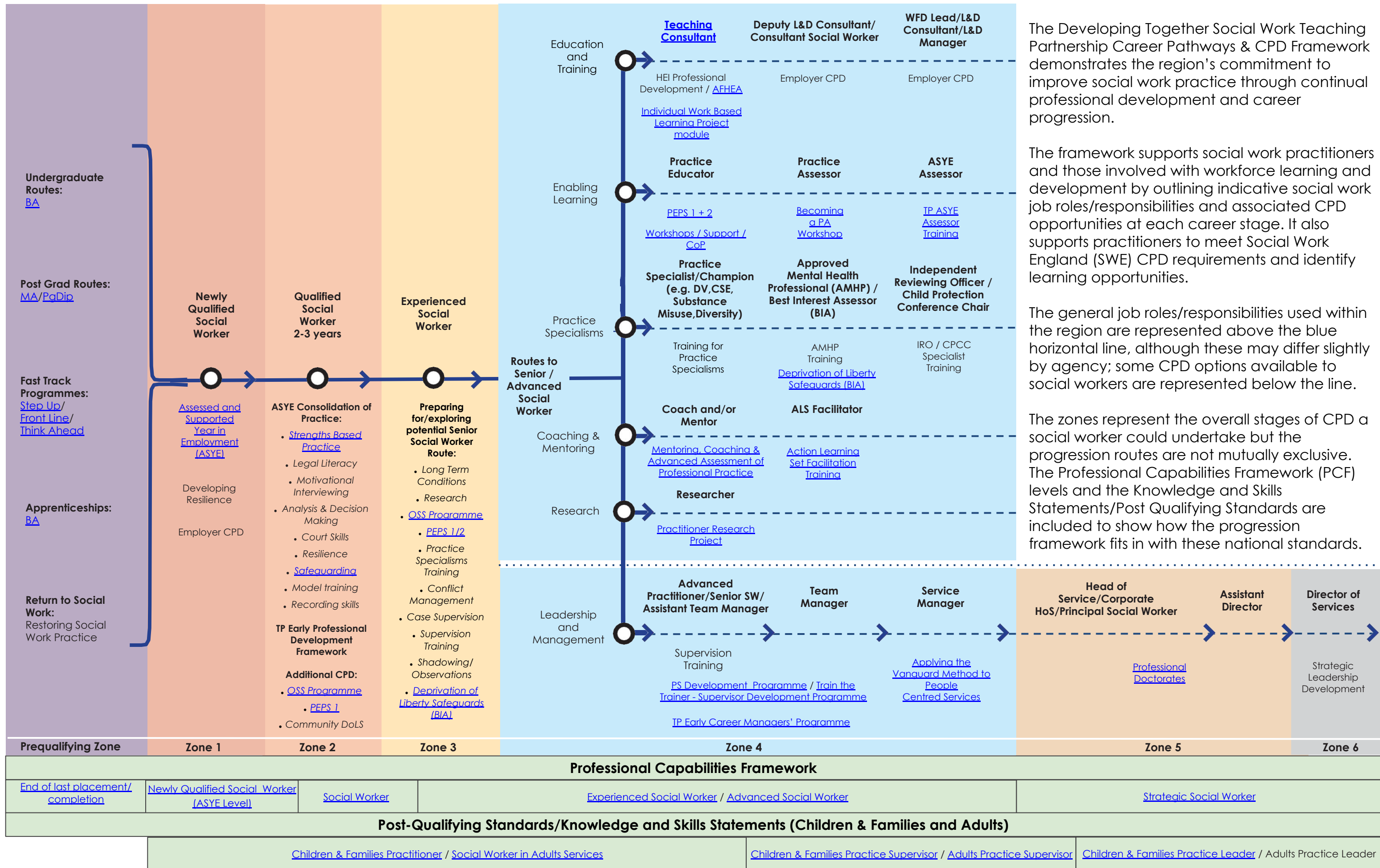


Career Pathways & CPD Framework



The Developing Together Social Work Teaching Partnership Career Pathways & CPD Framework demonstrates the region's commitment to improve social work practice through continual professional development and career progression.

The framework supports social work practitioners and those involved with workforce learning and development by outlining indicative social work job roles/responsibilities and associated CPD opportunities at each career stage. It also supports practitioners to meet Social Work England (SWE) CPD requirements and identify learning opportunities.

The general job roles/responsibilities used within the region are represented above the blue horizontal line, although these may differ slightly by agency; some CPD options available to social workers are represented below the line.

The zones represent the overall stages of CPD a social worker could undertake but the progression routes are not mutually exclusive. The Professional Capabilities Framework (PCF) levels and the Knowledge and Skills Statements/Post Qualifying Standards are included to show how the progression framework fits in with these national standards.
